



ISPS Code - All Crew Security Awareness Course

Introduction

Employers of personnel who work on vessels are required by the International Ship and Port Facility Security Code (ISPS Code) to train ALL CREW, even those without specific security duties in certain subjects. This course is designed to more than meet those requirements for training.

Who Should attend and Entry Level

This course is suitable for:

- Employers to train their personnel

Or

- Those employed, or seeking to be employed as crew

There is no prior training or experience required. However, basic literacy and numeracy are required due to course content & knowledge of the maritime industry would be useful.

Course Content and Duration

The course is run over around 5 hrs and covers:

- ISPS Code background & introduction
- Maritime security threats, security levels & the ship security plan
- Emergency procedures & contingency plans
- Suspicious persons & behaviour & circumvention of security
- Weapons & explosives

Assesment

Candidates will be continually assessed during the delivery of training by the course tutor for their understanding of the subject matter covered.

Qualification

Candidates will receive a ISPS Code All Crew Security Awareness certificate issued by Eos Risk Management Ltd.
