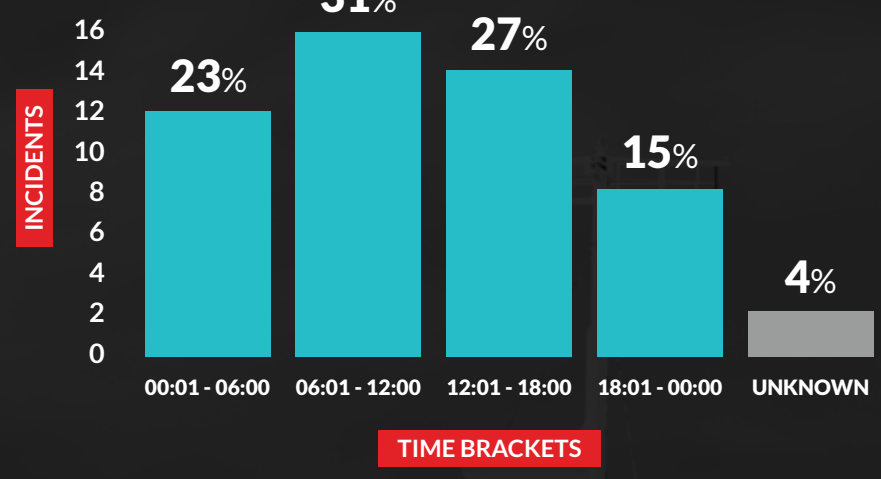

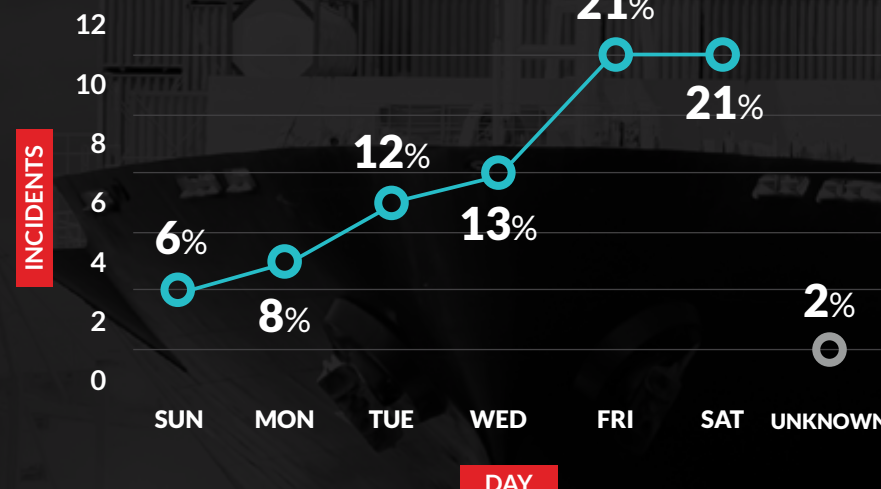

ON WHICH INCIDENTS OCCURRED

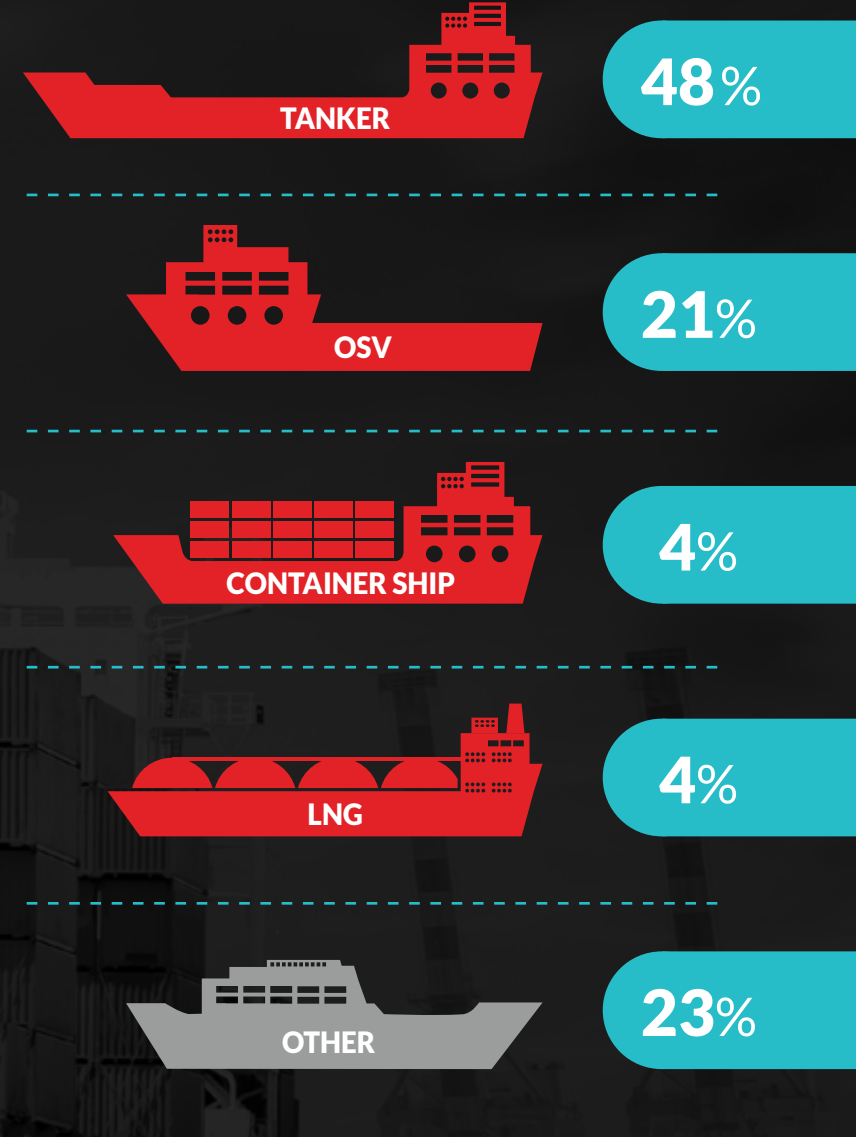


## MONTHLY

TIMELINE OF INCIDENTS

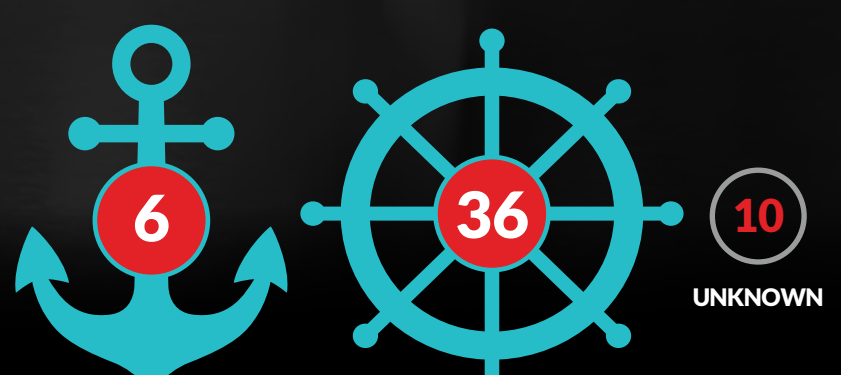


## VICTIM VESSEL TYPE

WHEN CONFIRMED ATTACKS OCCURRED

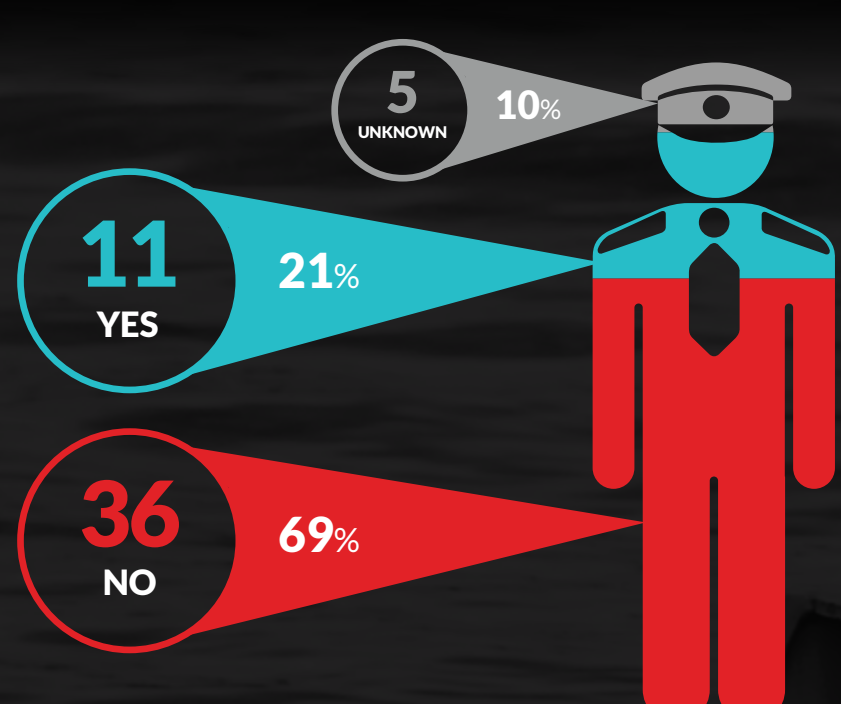


## EXCLUSIVE ECONOMIC ZONES

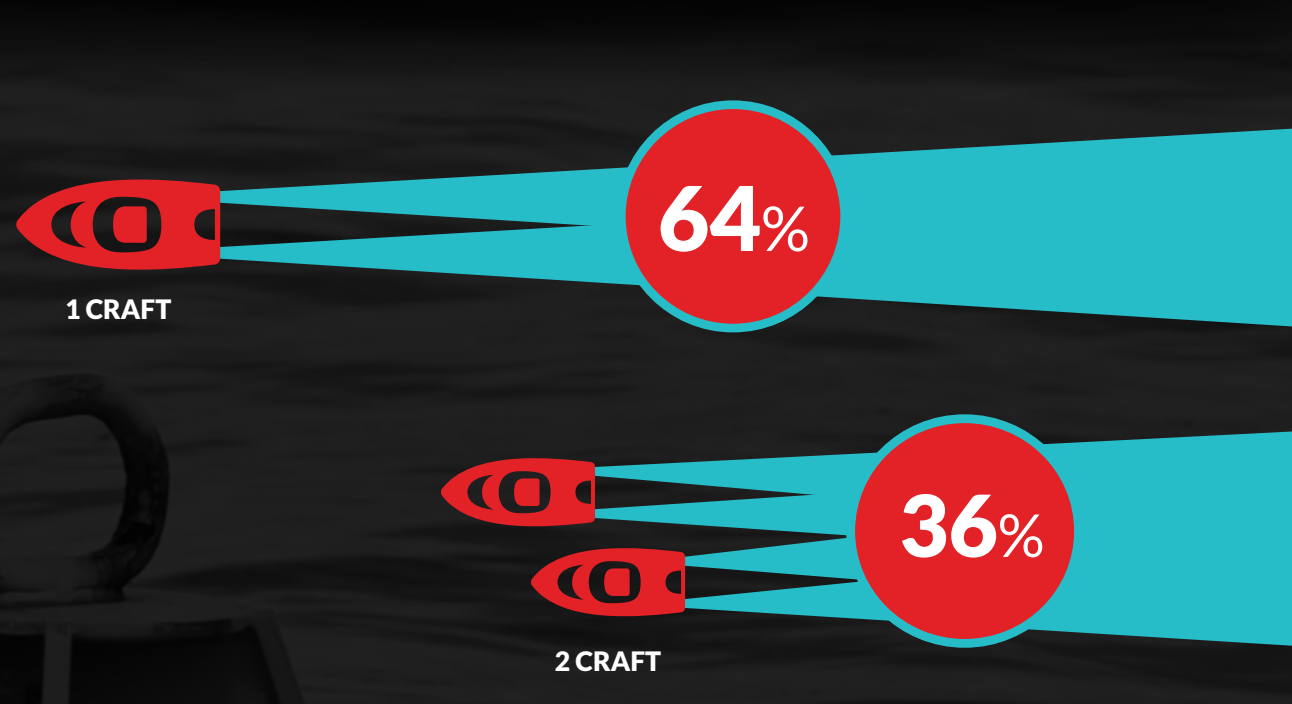

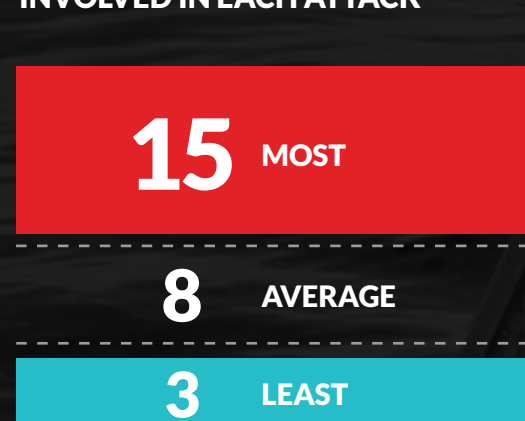
## ARMED SECURITY PRESENT ONBOARD WHEN ATTACKED

PIRATES ONLY BOARDED ONE VESSEL WITH ARMED SECURITY ONBOARD

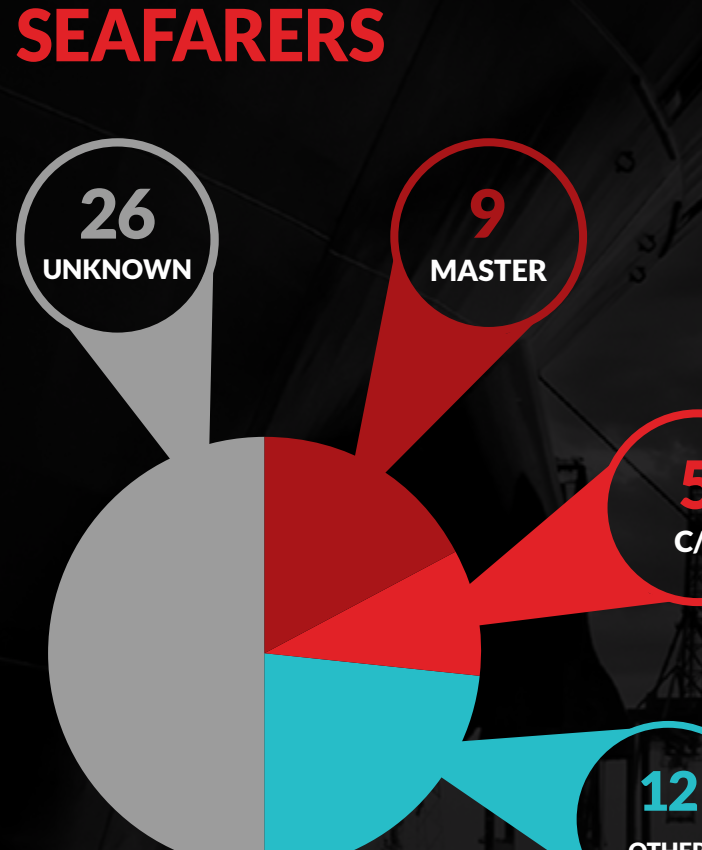

MASTER INCLUDED IN KIDNAP VICTIMS IN ALL BUT ONE CASE WHERE VICTIM RANKS WERE KNOWN

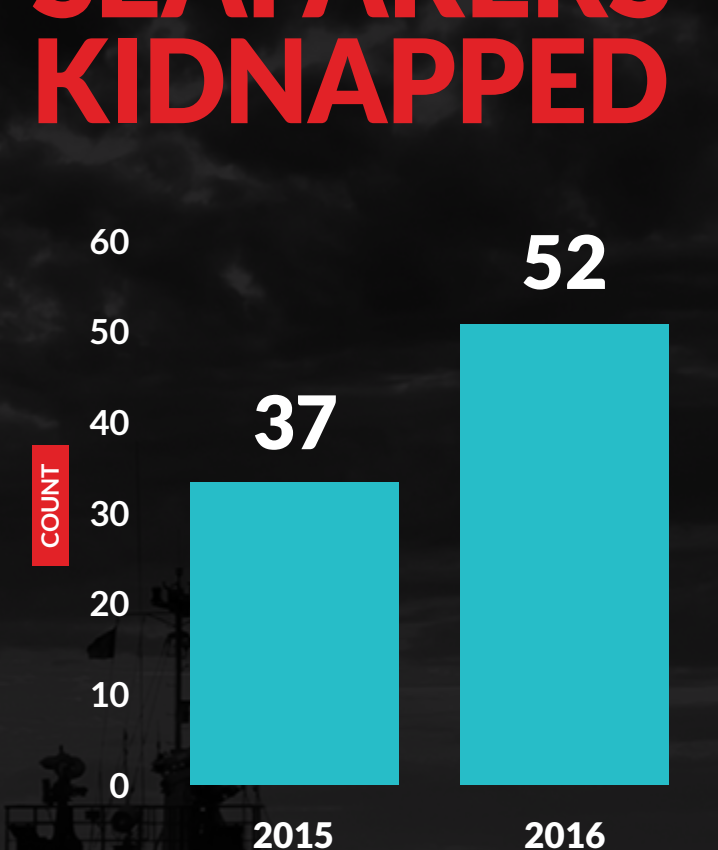
## RANKS OF KIDNAPED SEAFARERS



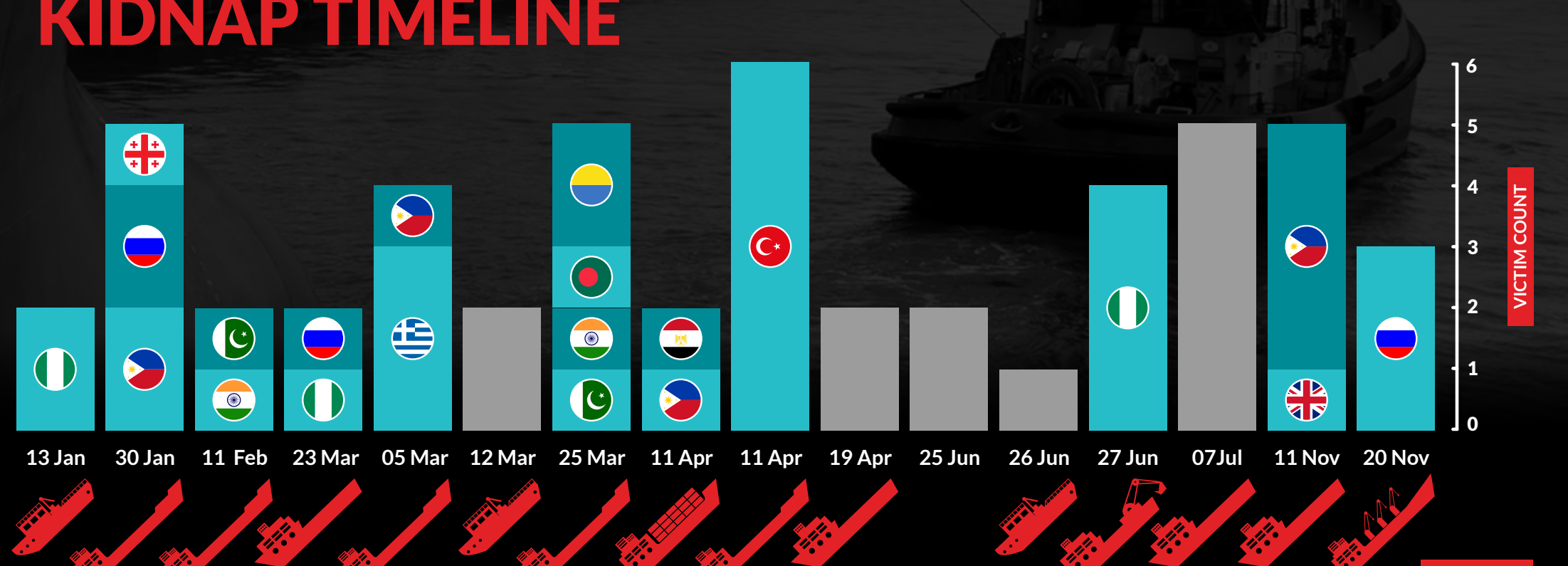
